1. Where we were: context and challenge

Context

- Cancellation of EQE in 2020 due to Corona pandemic
- Organisation of EQE in 2021 impossible due to ongoing health crisis
- Largest number of candidates ever in 2021
 - near 3 800 backlog of near 2 000
 - in case of cancellation → possibly 5 500 candidates in 2022
- Prior analogic examination environment
 - only handwrite papers possible
 - digital search, copy & paste etc. not allowed

Probably one of the most complete online examinations ever


97% of the 1 455 candidates who answered the survey welcomed the opportunity to take the EQE in 2021




77% of the 1 455 people had no experience in online exams¹



What candidates would welcome (respondents to the second survey):

Possibility to divide screen

Text editor with new features

Enabling shortcuts

43%

Possibility to open more than 10 tabs

Most important aspects regarding improvement of text editor:

Ability to highlight excerpts of text

Possibility to navigate through document without scrolling

Ability to compare two documents or text fragments

Inclusion of search function



Communication with invigilators:

Rating of chat functionality: very good to adequate
